Dr. Guy van Hazel is a medical oncologist whose private practice is at Mount Hospital in West Perth. He is also Clinical Professor of Medicine at School of Medicine and Pharmacology at the University of Western Australia and has been a lead investigator for several international clinical trials, including studies of selective internal radiation therapy (SIRT) in patients with liver dominant or liver only metastatic colorectal cancer.

He is a frequent speaker at national and international meetings, and has authored or co-authored scientific articles in *the Annals of Oncology*, *European Journal of Cancer*, *British Journal of Cancer*, *Journal of Gastrointestinal Cancer*, *Journal of Clinical Oncology*, and *Clinical Cancer Research*.

Dr. van Hazel is a member of the Royal Australasian College of Physicians, Royal College of Physicians of London, Royal College of Physicians of Edinburgh, American Society of Clinical Oncology, American Association of Cancer Research, Australian Medical Association, Australian/New Zealand Breast Cancer Study Group, Clinical Oncology Society of Australia, and the European Society of Medical Oncology. He is a designated investigator of the US National Cancer Institute (NIH).
