Dr. Fred M. Moeslein graduated from the Case Western Reserve University School of Medicine in 2001. He is an Assistant Professor of Radiology and Radiation Oncology at the University of Maryland School of Medicine in Baltimore.

Dr. Moeslein was the first interventional radiologist in Maryland to perform a successful irreversible electroporation (IRE) procedure. He specializes in diagnostic radiology and vascular and interventional radiology, with a special interest in interventional oncology and hepatobiliary interventions, particularly in respect to primary and metastatic hepatic neoplasms and pancreatic cancer.

He has written numerous book chapters and peer-reviewed articles in such publications as the *Journal of Vascular and Interventional Radiology*, *Cardiovascular and Interventional Radiology and Emergency Radiology*, and has lectured both nationally and internationally on a variety of Interventional topics, most importantly Selective Internal Radiotherapy (SIRT) and Pancreatic Irreversible Electroporation. His current research is in the fields of Selective Internal Radiotherapy, Robotic Assisted Guidance, and Irreversible Electroporation.
