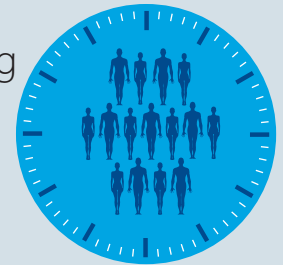

This equates to around as many as **36,471 deaths a year** in the US...



...that's **100** lives **every day**.⁴⁻⁷
