Professor Bruno Sangro is a hepatologist and Director of the Liver Unit at Clínica Universidad de Navarra, as well as Professor of Medicine at the University of Navarra School of Medicine, and senior researcher in the Spanish National Biomedical Research Network Centre for Liver and Digestive Diseases. His research focuses mainly on liver cancer, with a high priority focus on therapeutic innovation.

The Liver Unit he directs at Clínica Universidad has pioneered several approaches to the treatment of liver cancer, developing expanded criteria for liver transplantation, and advancing the use of locoregional vascular therapy, including intra-arterial infusion chemotherapy, transarterial embolisation, gene therapy and, more recently, liver radioembolisation. He leads the radioembolisation programme at Clínica Universidad where more than 300 patients have been treated since 2003.

Professor Sangro also serves as the Head of the Area for Digestive and Metabolic Diseases in the Navarra Health Research Institute, in Pamplona, Spain. An internationally recognised expert in the field of liver cancer, Dr. Sangro has authored more than a hundred scientific papers and serves on the editorial board of several medical journals. He is also an advisor to the National Spanish Agency for Medicinal Products, and is a member of a number of national and international medical societies.
