



Bruno Sangro MD, PhD

Dr. Bruno Sangro is Director of the Liver Unit at Clinica Universitaria de Navarra, Professor of Medicine at the University of Navarra School of Medicine, and senior researcher in the National Biomedical Research Network Center for Liver and Digestive Diseases.

He also serves in the Governing Board of the Division of Hepatology and Gene Therapy at the Centre for Applied Biomedical Research, in Pamplona, Spain.

A recognised expert in the field of liver cancer, Dr. Sangro has authored more than a hundred scientific paper and serves on the editorial board of several medical journals.

He is Advisor for the National Spanish Agency for Medicinal Products. Dr. Sangro is a member of a number of national and international medical societies.

Dr Sangro's basic and clinical research has mainly focused on liver cancer, with a high priority focus on therapeutic innovation.

The Liver Unit of Clinica Universitaria has pioneered several approaches to the treatment of liver cancer from expanded criteria for liver transplantation to locoregional vascular therapy, including intraarterial infusion chemotherapy, transarterial embolisation, gene therapy and, more recently, liver radioembolisation. He leads the radioembolisation programme at Clinica Universitaria where more than 300 patients have been treated.
